

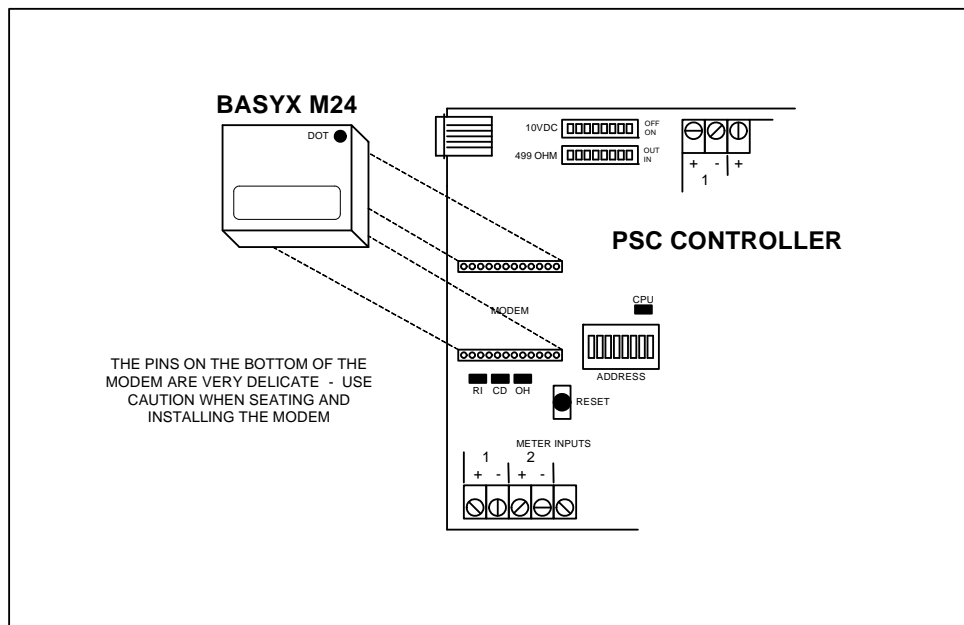

BULLETIN: BASYX M24 Modem Installation

The BASYX PSC controllers utilize a plug-in style modem for remote communications with the system.

The BASYX M24 is a 2400 baud modem, and MUST be installed on the first controller in the system which is setup as ADDRESS 1 for proper operation. When holding the PSC controller horizontally with relays to the right, a double row socket will be visible at the LEFT edge of the board, and will have the word MODEM printed between the rows.

If board 1 has the optional analog output board installed, the modem will plug directly into the top of the AO board.



The modem has a dot which will be on the upper right corner when positioned properly.

Note that some pins have been cut from the modem. MAKE SURE THAT THE UNIT IS LINED UP PROPERLY BEFORE PUSHING INTO THE SOCKETS.
